

Have you seen pest fish in your local area?

FeralFishScan is a new web-mapping system for the community to record pest fish in local waterways.

- Record sightings of carp, tilapia, goldfish, red fin perch, oriental weatherloach and eastern gambusia.
- Keep local authorities informed about current problems.
- View the fish map to see where pest fish occur in your area
- Upload photos of pest fish to the website.

How to record pest fish in your local area

Option 1. Go to www.feralfishscan.org.au




Register your details and Login, or record data using your email address.

Submit your record, and view it on the Map. View other records in your local area.
