FeralPigScan is a new web-mapping system for landholders to record feral pig activity in their local area.


- Record sightings, feral pig evidence, impacts (such as damage crops), and control activities (such as trapping).
- Keep local authorities informed about current pig problems.
- Work together to identify priority areas for control.
- Create an online group for your landholder network.
- Receive updates about local control and feral pig issues.

Register your Name, or simply record data using your email address.




Record where you have seen feral pigs, evidence, damage, and control actions.
