Are Feral Goats causing problems in your local area?

Record information into FeralGoatScan to help protect farmers and biodiversity.

FeralGoatScan is a free community resource for monitoring, mapping and managing feral goats. People are using FeralGoatScan to record feral goat activity and coordinate local control programs. It can be used by landholders, community groups, local government, pest controllers and biosecurity organisations. Download the App



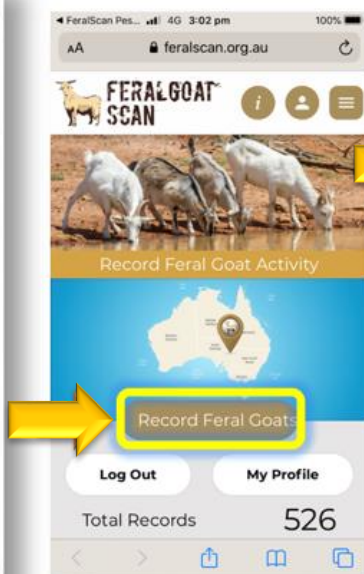
Recording feral goat information in 4 simple steps

1. Select Goat



From the app home screen select the feral goat image.

2. Open the map



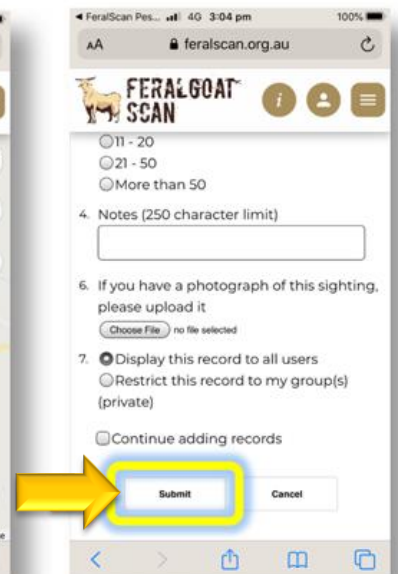
Click 'Record Feral Goats' to open the map.

3. Record data



Select 'Record data' then answer all relevant questions.

4. Submit report



Upload a photo (optional) then select 'Submit'.
