



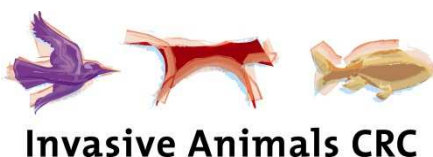
## Have you seen feral pigs in your local area?

**FeralPigScan is a new web-mapping system for landholders to record feral pig activity in their local area.**

- Record sightings, feral pig evidence, impacts (such as ripped soil), and control activities (such as trapping).
- Keep local authorities informed about current problems.
- Work together to identify priority areas for control.
- Create an online group for your landholder network.
- Receive updates about local control programs.

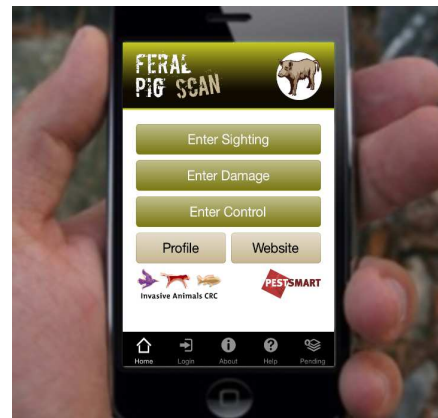

Option 1. Go to the website

Submit your record, and view it on the website. View other sightings in your local area.
