



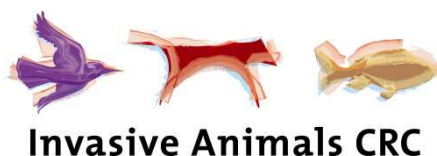
## Have you seen foxes in your local area?

**FoxScan is a new web-mapping system for landholders to record fox activity in their local area.**

- Foxes impact on livestock production and native wildlife.
- Record sightings of foxes, fox evidence, impacts (such as dead lambs) and control actions (such as baiting).
- Keep local authorities informed about current fox problems.
- Join a landholder group online to keep your members informed about current fox activity.
- Receive alerts and updates about local fox activity.

# How to record fox activity in FoxScan

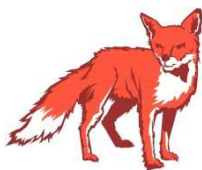
Option 1. Go to the website

Submit your record, and view it on the map. View other fox records in your local area.
